The Slovak Green Building Council (SKGBC) was founded in November 2010 as a non-profit civic association.

During these years, the organisation has become a renowned and well-known organisation with the support of an international network. **The SKGBC is the main ambassador of sustainable constructions in Slovakia.**

The supreme body of the organisation is the assembly of members, which elects its board. The executive body of the organisation is the secretariat, headed by the executive director, who is being appointed by the board.

OUR MISSION

We implement ecological, economical, and social aspects of sustainable constructions, education, and networking for experts and general public, and establish specialised dialogue on sustainable constructions.

OUR VISION

Economical, ecological and aesthetic buildings with healthy interiors, not wasting energy and other resources, becoming the standard in Slovakia.

OUR GOAL

Making sure all new and reconstructed old buildings are erected using standards of sustainability, reducing energy consumption, eliminating the impact of buildings to the environment, and minimising the carbon footprint.

OUR ACTIVITIES



EDUCATION AND EVENTS

We perform education activities with the goal to introduce latest trends and knowledge on sustainable constructions. The systemic specialised education is being provided by the GREEN BUILDING ACADEMY, consisting of 7 modules. The international conference of GREEN BUILDING SUMMIT is the summit event on this topic in the area of Central Europe, full of inspiration and practical experience from abroad. The traditional events series of the Green Building Week is being accompanied by the thematic tours of buildings of the GREEN WALK-GREEN TALK.



PROJECTS

In cooperation with our members, other associations and scholars, in 2022, we started the Initiative for Modern Wooden Constructions with the goal to support wood as a sustainable material in modern constructions. We took part in many international projects. One of them was aimed to prepare the students for the practical life in the area of sustainable buildings. Another one was the SMARTER Finance for Families project, which supports new mechanisms of funding new buildings and renovation of old ones.



LEGISLATION

We are the co-founder of the Buildings for Future platform, with its main mission being active cooperation in creating public policies with effect on the construction and renovation of buildings, focusing on energy efficiency, healthy interiors, and sustainability. Via this platform, we take part in the legislation processes. Thanks to an active member from the world of legal services, we are able to provide regular monitoring of construction, environmental, and energy related legislation.



PARTNERSHIP AND NETWORKING

Events are an ideal platform to find new business contacts and opportunities. We organise various specialised and networking events and cooperate with professional and interest organisations, institutions, business and professional chambers, like SKA, SKSI, Buildings for Future, Passive Houses Institute, Green Roofs, as well as universities. MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

EXCLUSIVE MEMBER

The exclusive membership is for legal companies interested in exclusive cooperation and higher visibility at the council's activities. Exclusive members get individual approach and care provided by the SKGBC team members in order to achieve maximum utilization of all the benefits of our cooperation.

REGULAR MEMBER

Regular membership is for legal entities. Regular members may participate in all activities of the council. They have a voting right and company representatives may seek election to the council bodies. All regular members have the same voting rights (one vote per member).

ASSOCIATED MEMBER

Associated membership is for education and scientific institutions, non-profit organisations and subjects who are not businesses. They do not have a right to vote and to seek election into the council board. It offers the possibility of partnerships at specialised seminars and active participation in activities and projects, as well as in working groups.



BENEFITS OF MEMBERSHIP

REGULAR MEMBERSHIP

Regular membership is for legal entities. Regular members may participate in all activities of the council. They have a voting right and company representatives may seek election to the council bodies. All regular members have the same voting rights (one vote per member).

LEGISLATION

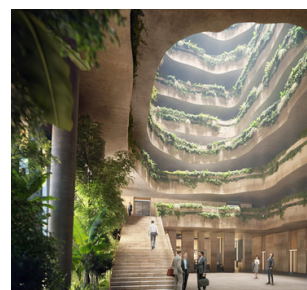

- Members receive information on events organised by the platform and are able to take active part in the events and networking meetings.
- Members are able to directly affect the creation and development of Slovak legislation in form of comments implementing the principles of sustainable buildings.
- Members also receive regular monthly monitoring of construction, environmental, and energy related legislation.

NETWORKING

- Members are able to make new business connections with members and non-members at the regular specialised and networking events of the SKGBC.
- As part of the selected events, there is the social section, which is an ideal platform to make new business contacts with companies from the sustainable construction industry.

- Exclusive members have the right to participate in creating strategy and plan of activities of the SKGBC.

EXCLUSIVE CONTACTS AND RELATIONSHIP

- We organise meetings of exclusive members with the purpose of closer cooperation.
- Exclusive members are being informed on the SKGBC meetings with public authorities, self-governing region bodies, and international organisations, and may nominate persons to represent them at those meetings.
- Exclusive members receive partnership offers for key events of the council first (conferences, specialised seminars, work breakfasts, evening clubs).

EXCLUSIVE VISIBILITY AND PROMOTION

- We display the logos of exclusive members labelled as “Exclusive member” at the main documents of the council (Annual Report) and they are given priority spots on the webpage of www.skgbc.org.
- The logos of our exclusive members are also being displayed in the SKGBC email signature.
- Exclusive members may become ambassadors of one of the topics the SKGBC is focusing on (has to be approved by the board).
- Representatives of the exclusive members may act as hosts at specialised events of the SKGBC.
- The SKGBC may provide support of a project or event of the exclusive members (has to be approved by the board).
- joint events of exclusive members and the council may be listed in the event plan of the SKGBC. We will support such events by contacting the target group.
- Support of PR activities of the exclusive members by promotion of the projects by means of joint press releases.

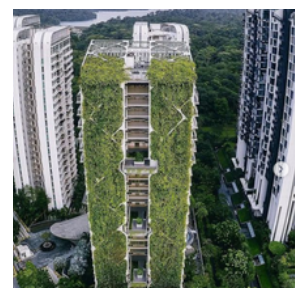
The benefits of membership with the SKGBC grows with the proactive approach of the members and their engagement in the activities of the council.

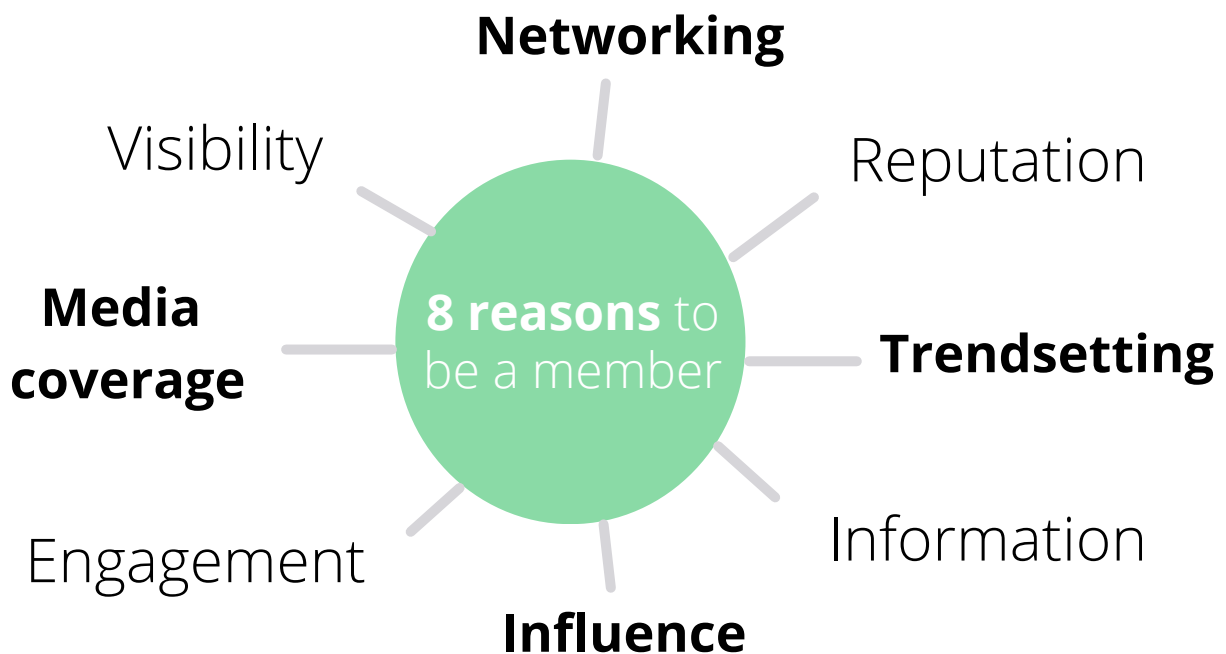
